

# OCA BANTAM SKILL DEVELOPMENT CAMP

## 2009-10 Bantam Skill Development Camp

### *Overview*

In support of athletes who have the potential to compete in the Canada Winter Games in 2011, the OCC (Ontario Curling Council) and the OCA (Ontario Curling Association) are pleased to announce the creation of the Bantam Skill Development Camp to be held on March 19 to 21, 2010 in Alliston Ontario. This camp has been made possible by a grant from the Ministry of Health Promotion and Sport Alliance of Ontario.

### *Eligibility*

Players must be a minimum of 12 and a maximum of 17 years of age on December 31, 2010. That is, they must have been born on January 1, 1993 to December 31, 1998 inclusive. **All players** wishing to be considered for invitation to the camp must complete and submit an individual application form.

The members of the top three bantam boy's teams and the top three bantam girl's teams at OCA Bantam Provincials in Gananoque in February 2010 will automatically be extended an invitation to the camp and will be expected to submit an application and attend. That invitation will include four players and one coach for each team. Invitations will also be extended to four additional bantam boys and four additional bantam girls as selected from applications received and 2 additional coaches. Players are asked to include the name of their coach as well as the coach's certification level on their applications. This information will not be used as part of the individual's evaluation and is for information purposes only. The committee will evaluate all applications and extend invitations to those who demonstrate the highest potential for reaching the Canada Winter Games based on the attached set of criteria.

# OCA BANTAM SKILL DEVELOPMENT CAMP

## *Camp Outline*

The goal of the camp is to provide high performance instruction to bantam aged players who might not otherwise get that level of instruction. The weekend will consist of a variety of activities ranging from workshop seminars to group activities to on ice development work. Each team will be assigned an experienced mentor coach who will work with them over the weekend. Some of the areas that will be covered include:

- Delivery analysis including video analysis using the VHI Home system
- Strategy
- Game Situations
- Mental Preparation
- Team Dynamics
- Physical Preparation
- Education session for coaches

The cost for the camp will be \$50 per person (players & coaches) and this will include accommodation for both Friday and Saturday night (double occupancy), lunches Saturday and Sunday, snacks as well as all instruction and materials.

Application Deadline: Midnight, January 31, 2010

Announcement of Selected Camp Attendees: February 19, 2010

### Age Eligibility:

Minimum age 12 and maximum age 17 as of December 31, 2010.

(Birth date of Jan 1, 1993 to December 31, 1998 inclusive)

### A. Criteria for teams (4 players and 1 coach)

- Top 3 boys teams and top 3 girls teams in the final standings at the 2009-10 Bantam Provincials
- Note: The applicants from the Provincial winning teams still need to be age eligible for 2011 Canada Winter Games.

### B. Criteria for individuals

- Once team positions are filled, individual applicants will be selected using the criteria listed on the application form.
- Consider the period from May 1, 2008 to present only (with the exception of the March 2008 Ontario Winter Game).
- Points are assigned for each occurrence in this period.
- Exclude mixed events.
- **An equal number of boys and girls will be selected**
